- 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners will be chosen for each grade band Elementary (K-5), Middle (6-8), and High (9-12) for each County!
- Artwork will be judged on creativity, attractiveness, and theme
- Artwork will be displayed at the Department of Education from May 8th- June 8th. They will also be posted online at the project website.
- Winners will be invited to attend a special ceremony on June 9th Fred Fifer III Middle School (Caesar Rodney School District)
